

Santa Fe College Rules Manual

Title: Qualifications for Instructional Personnel Rule 3.2

General Authority: FS 1001.02(6) Law Implemented: FS 1001.02(6), 1001.64

Effective Date: January 19, 2022

Purpose: To authorize the College to establish a process for determining minimum qualifications for College instructional personnel in accordance with requirements of the regional accrediting body, and to provide for the verification of credentials through appropriate documentation of educational and experiential credentials.

The College shall use the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) faculty credential guidelines, requirements of other applicable program-specific accrediting agencies, and applicable state statutes to identify appropriate credentials for faculty teaching courses in all programs of study.

The faculty credentials must be clearly identified in a Faculty Credentialing Manual that presents Santa Fe College's process for justifying and documenting the qualifications of all faculty members. The President may authorize the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs to establish, implement, and maintain the written credentialing process described herein, in which case the Faculty Credentialing Manual shall be maintained by the office of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.

The District Board authorizes the President to establish additional procedures implementing this rule if needed.
