

Title: Bicycles, Skateboards, Scooters, Rule 6.7

Skates, and Other Transportation Devices

General Authority: FS 1001.64

Law Implemented: FS 1001.64(5), 1001.65(6), 316.2065

Effective Date: July 19, 2016

Purpose: To establish regulations regarding the use of bicycles, skateboards, scooters,

skates, hoverboards, Segways, and other non-vehicular personal transportation

devices on premises owned or controlled by Santa Fe College.

Bicycle traffic shall be restricted to those roadways open to motor vehicles. All other sidewalks, passageways, concourses, and hallways are closed to bicycle traffic unless clearly marked and designated for such traffic.

All persons using a bicycle upon the property of Santa Fe College shall comply with the provisions of Sec. 316.2065, Florida Statutes.

Skateboards, scooters, roller skates, in-line skates, hoverboards, Segways and other non-vehicular personal transportation devices may not be utilized anywhere on the property of Santa Fe College unless authorized in writing by the President or a member of President's staff.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, reasonable and necessary use of any non-vehicular personal transportation device for purposes of accommodating a disability is not prohibited by this rule.

Violations of this rule by students may result in referral to the Office of Student Conduct with sanctions to be governed by the Student Conduct Code. Violations of this rule by employees may result in disciplinary action relate to employment, up to and including termination. Violations of this rule by visitors may result in warnings, up to and including a Trespass Notice.
