



ACTUAL EXPENDITURES







SALARY & BENEFIT SUPPORT HISTORY

- 1. 2009 FT \$1,000 non-recurring salary supplement
- 2. 2010 FT \$1,000 added to base salary (raised all minimum pay grade salary ranges by same) plus 5%
- 3. 2011 FT Two steps added to base plus 2.5%
- 4. 2012 FT Added 2% to base salary and \$500 non-recurring salary supplement
- 5. 2013 FT Added 5% to base salary



SALARY & BENEFIT SUPPORT HISTORY

- 6. 2014 FT Added 2% to base salary and \$500 non-recurring salary supplement
- 7. 2015 FT \$1,000 non-recurring salary supplement
- 8. 2016 FT added 2% to base salary plus additional \$650 to Career Service bases and \$1,250 non-recurring salary supplement in November and March

SALARY & BENEFIT SUPPORT HISTORY

AND

2017-2018

Recommending ALL full-time personnel, employed in a full-time capacity as of June 1, 2018, receive a non-recurring \$1,000 supplement to their 2017-18 employment contract for services performed during the period of April 1, 2018 through May 31, 2018, or a prorated share based on the days of full-time employment for this period. This will be paid on the June 30, 2018 pay date.
