We want this to be the most meaningful and educational experience possible for our students, but it will take your time and effort to make it successful. The first step in reserving your spot is getting your application and registration. Spaces will be reserved on **first come first serve basis**, so reserve your space early.

Your participation is free and you get to keep everything you make (Sales Tax excluded) Applicant must be a currently enrolled student at Santa Fe College. Both Application fee and Space fee are free to you as a student. Registration is due March 1, 2024. All other information and rules apply (See attached).

This year's student section will be housed under a large canopy tent provided by Santa Fe College near the Fine Arts Hall.

All student vendors will be provided with one 6ft table and two chairs. Space will be limited for additional display materials, so plan to enhance your table's presentation. Try to think of creative ways to display your work. We will be hosting workshops for students to discuss display concepts, pricing your work, best practices, printing, framing, and more.

Spring Arts Staff will email you by March 15th once your application is accepted. Please check your email and reply to confirm your participation. You will be assigned a space in the student section, and you will receive an additional information packet.

Submission Guidelines: Completed application must be submitted to Springartsfestival@sfcollege.edu by no later 03/01/2024

All applicants will be required to submit 3-5 images that represent your work. Images should be in a PDF format and included with your application. All works must be original and follow copy write laws and regulations. This is a Fine Arts Festival. No food, animal, or plant sales are permitted.

The event schedule is Saturday 10am-5pm and Sunday 10am-4pm. We ask vendors to be present during the festival hours. You have the option to table both Saturday and Sunday or on only one day. Priority will be given to students who can be present for both days. Lunch will be provided to participants.

Please indicate the medium(s) you will be displaying. You may select more than one.

Ceramics - Original clay and porcelain work other than jewelry. If multiple pieces of the same design are displayed, the artist must sign each piece. No machine-made or mass-produced work is permitted.

Drawing and Printmaking - Works created using dry media including chalk, charcoal, pastels, pencil, wax crayons, etc., or from a fluid medium of inks and washes applied by pen or brush. Printed works for which the artists hand manipulated the plates, stones or screens and which have been properly signed and numbered as a limited edition may be entered in this category.

Digital Media, Graphic Design, & Digital Art - Art made using software, computers, or other electronic devices. Anything produced or made on digital media, such as animations, photographs, illustrations, videos, digital paintings, and such can be classified as digital art and may be entered in this category.

Fiber - All work crafted from fibers. No machine-tooled, machine-screened patterns or miscellaneous forms of mass production are permitted. All factory-produced wearable items, regardless of additional modification or enhancement by the artists, are not accepted in this category.

Glass- Glass works that are functional or decorative by design and are kiln formed or have been crafted by glass blowing, molding or casting. Works may be etched or engraved. No forms of mass production are permitted.

Jewelry - All jewelry, whether produced from metal, glass, clay, fiber, paper, plastic or other materials. No commercial casts, molds or production studio work is allowed.

Mixed Media 2-Dimensional - Works that incorporate more than one type of physical material in their production.

Painting 2-Dimensional - Works created in oils and/or acrylics and/or watercolor.

Mixed Media 3-Dimensional - Works that incorporate more than one type of physical material in their production. All work should be over 1 inch in depth.

Multidisciplinary Designer - Allows artists to present more than one type of artwork. This category is meant to encourage creativity and new works. Please include in the description of materials and techniques the primary focus of your work: 2-Dimensional or 3-Dimensional.

Photography - Photographic prints made from artist's original work processed either by the artist or under thier direct supervision.

Sculpture - 3-Dimensional original work done in any medium.

Wood - Original works that are hand tooled, machine-worked, turned or carved.
